DIFFERENT Location: Jeannie Werner's Arena 17970 S. Camden Av. Caruthers, CA 93609

This arena is on the frontage road of Hwy 41 just 2 miles north of Riverdale. **From 99 north**, take Hwy 41 South (in Fresno) toward Lemoore. Drive about 30 minutes to Elkhorn Ave. turn left and an immediate right onto frontage road. Arena will be 1/2 mile on left. **From the south..**Hwy 198 connects I5 and Hwy99. go North on Hwy 41 from Lemoore or from Kettleman city exit I5. Continue about 10 minutes (past Riverdale) to Harlan Ave. Turn Right and an immediate left onto frontage road. Arena is about 1 mile on right.

20 Sheep runs and 20 duck & cattle runs combined each trial on Saturday and Sunday.

Sheep and cattle course B and Ducks course A both days.

TRIAL 8AM SATURDAY PM trial immediately following. 7AM SUNDAY (handlers meeting 20 minutes prior to each trial) Run order will be determined by random draw prior to trial

CLASSES: Advanced, Open, Novice, Junior and Started

STOCK: SHEEP: 3-5 head Barbs **DUCKS:** 5 head Runner Cross **CATTLE:** 3-5 head Beef Cross

All entries must be on official ASCA entry form. Trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations

Returned check invalidates entry and will be charges a \$25 fee.

Entries will not be refunded for any reason after the closing date of Feb. 20, 2010

Exhibitors are responsible for any injuries to livestock. Replacement value will be posted at trial.

Non ASCA entries must be approved herding breeds and have an ASCA Tracking number forms@trial

(\$105.00 per trial all 3 types of stock) If entering all 4 trials/3 types of stock, reduce to \$100 per trial		

Pre-entry will be accepted beginning postmark **Sat. January 30, 2010**, and pre entry closing must be **Postmarked February 20, 2010.** Late entries and/or day of trial entries, if available, add \$10. per run.

Bitches in season may be substituted but will run in order and must be crated when not competing.

High Combined Aussie, High Combined Other Breed, Most Promising Started Aussie & Additional awards for High Combined Non-WTCH and Most Promising Started Other Breed must enter all 3 types of livestock, all 4 trials. NOTE: If only 1 dog is eligible for a buckle, it must have at least 9 scores.

Awards for each trial: High Score: Cattle, Sheep, Ducks, and HIT. High Score Jr. Handler and High Score Novice Handler ribbon and award. Class placement ribbons 1st -4th and qualifying ribbons.

Overnight camping is available at the site. Dogs must be leashed at all times. Please clean up after your dog!
